

Get Planning for your 2024 grant application

An application for a Hastings Cancer Trust grant can be submitted by, or on behalf of health care providers involved in the management of cancer patients or, a community organisation which supports cancer patients and/or cancer survivors and their carers in the Hastings, Camden Haven and Macleay districts.

The trustees will pay particular attention to how the funds applied for in the grant application will benefit the maximum number of cancer patients and those recovering from cancer.

If resources are not available to approve the full funding of the project outlined in the application, detailed costings would provide scope for the trustees to consider partial funding. Applications with matching funding sources would be looked upon favorably.

In 2024, due to the generosity of **THE HEART OF COURAGE** team, we will be having a special focus on grant applications that look to **CLOSE THE GAP** for Aboriginal communities access to cancer services, encourage cancer research and involve cancer patients in exercise programs.

As in previous years applications for a grant can be done online by going to our website www.hastingscancertrust.org.au pressing on the GRANTS & PROJECTS tab and then the COMPLETE ONLINE tab.

The application period opens on Monday 5th August and closes at 5.00pm on Friday 4th October, 2024.

All applicants will be advised of the result of their application by email or mail towards the end of October and successful applicants will be invited to attend a formal presentation of certificates in November, 2024.
